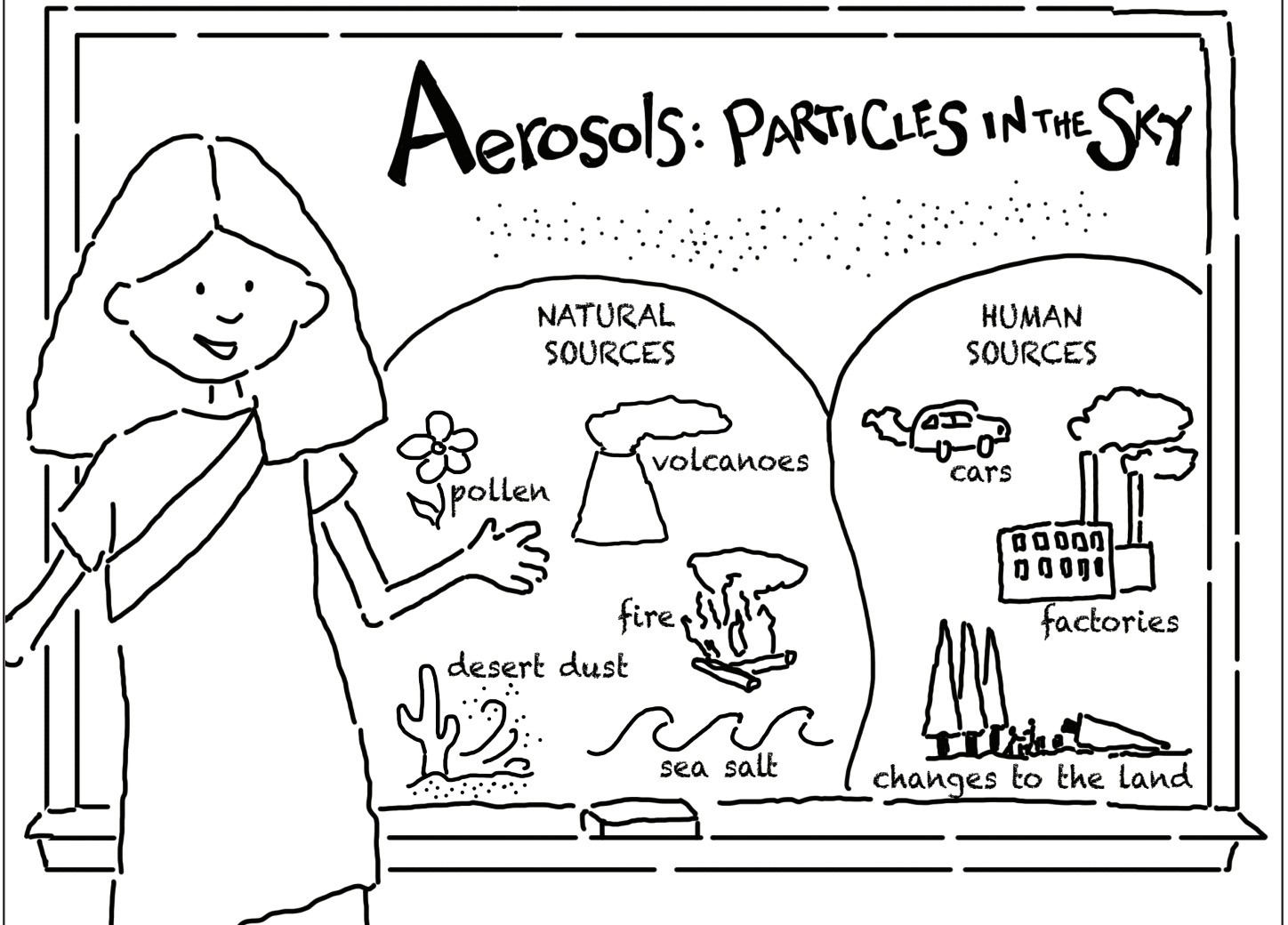

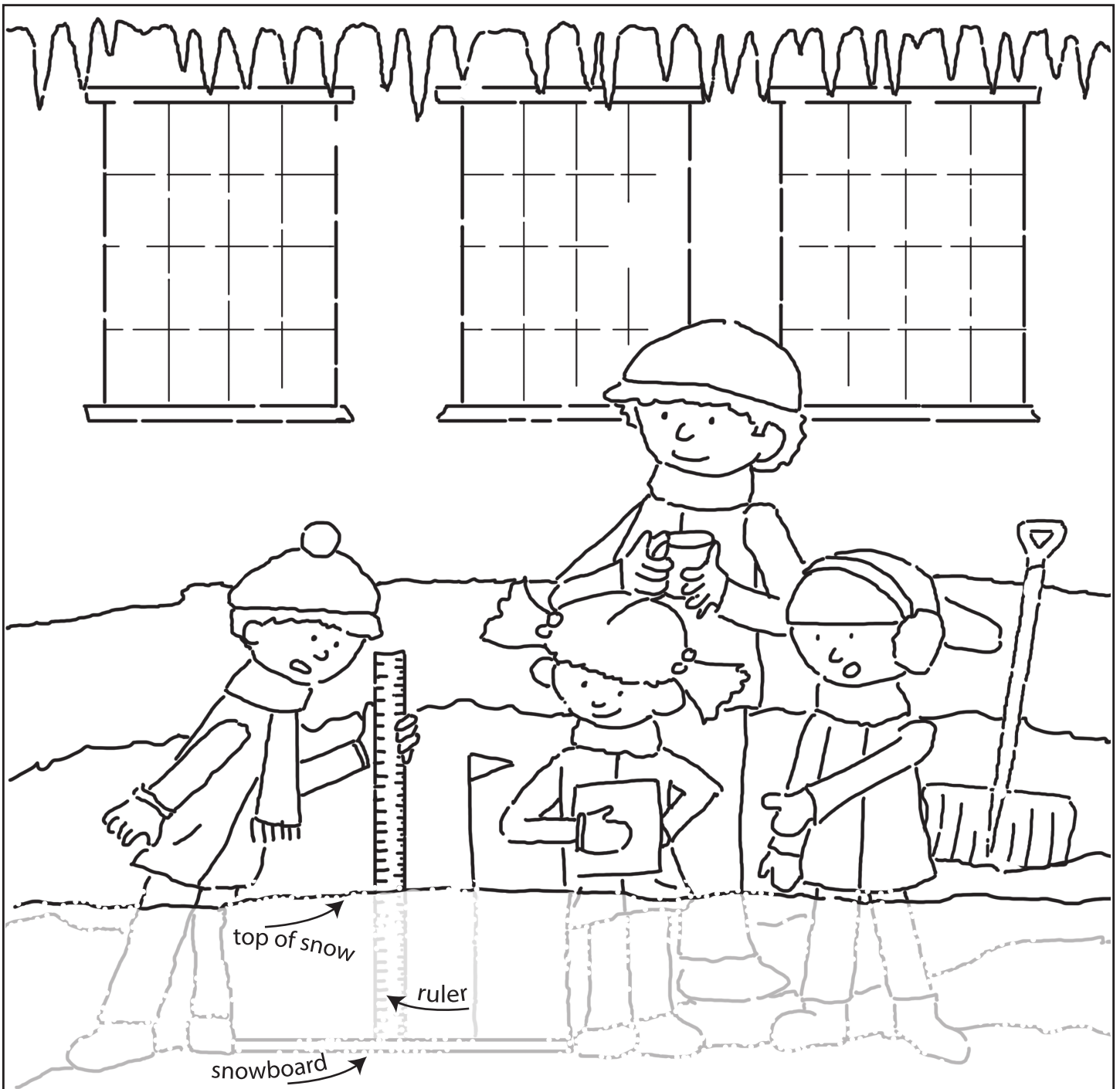
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Dennis, Anita, Simon, and Dr. Sanchez are measuring snow with a scientific snowboard. Measuring weather each day helps us understand our climate.

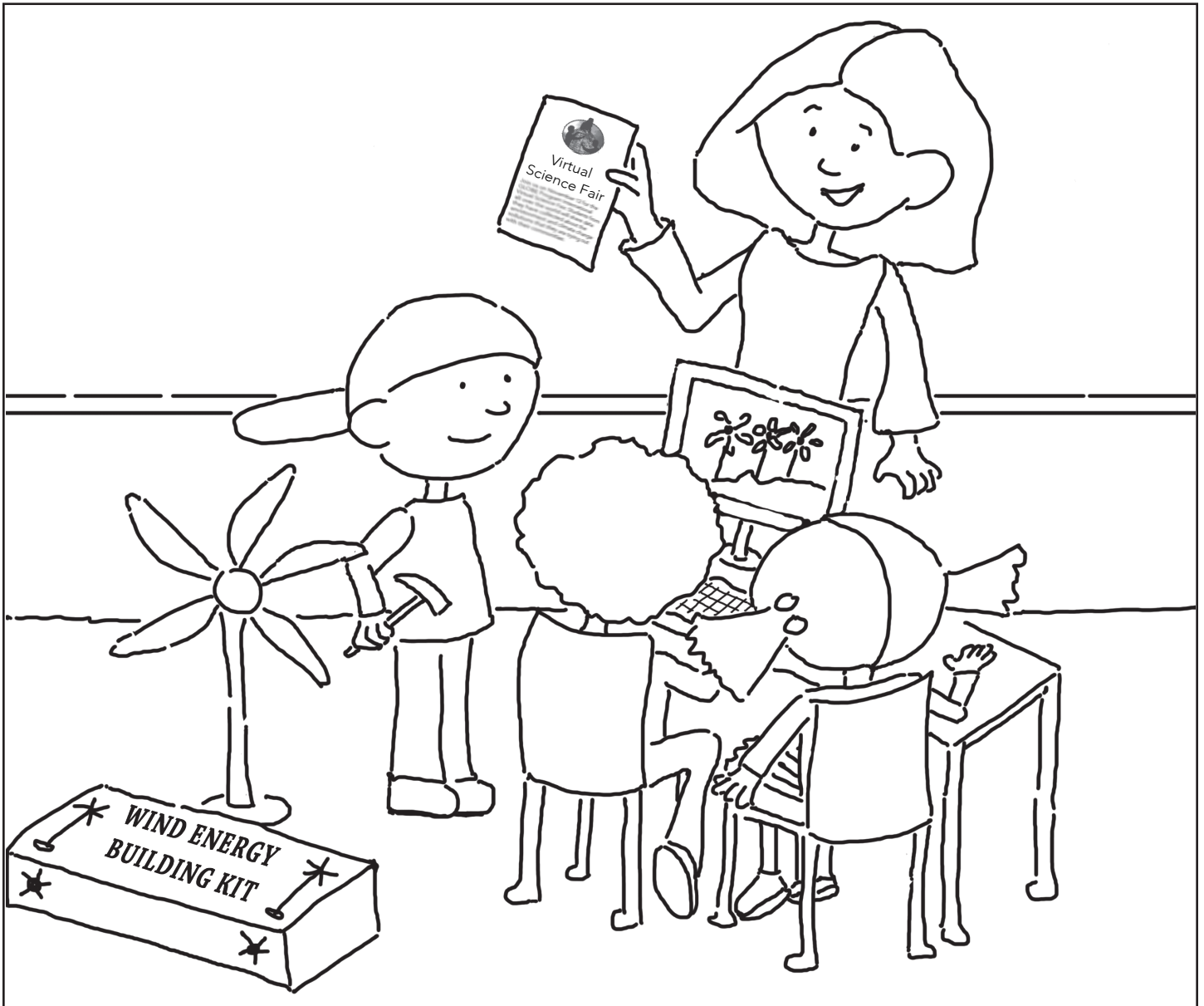

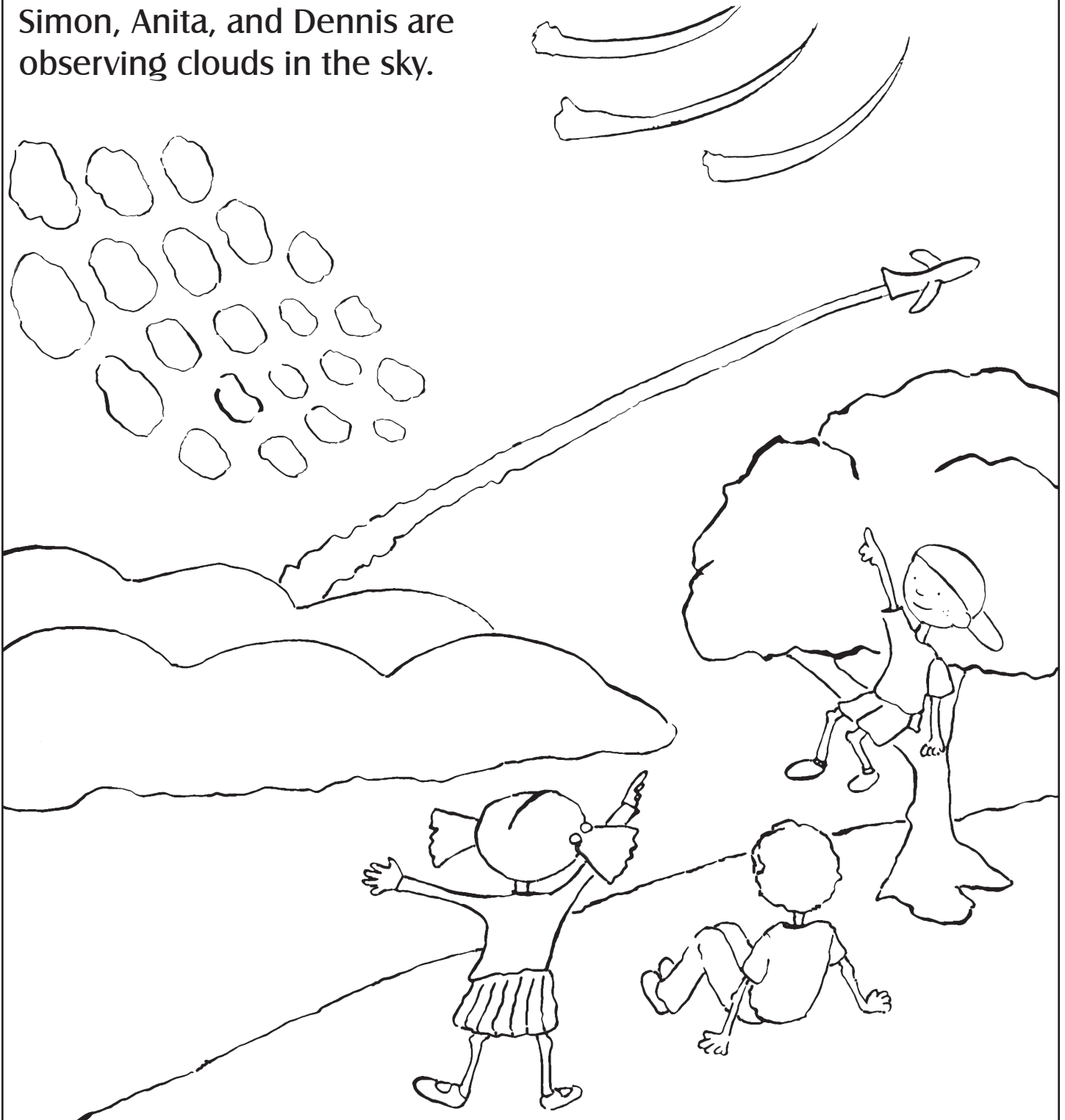
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Simon, Anita, and Dennis are observing clouds in the sky.

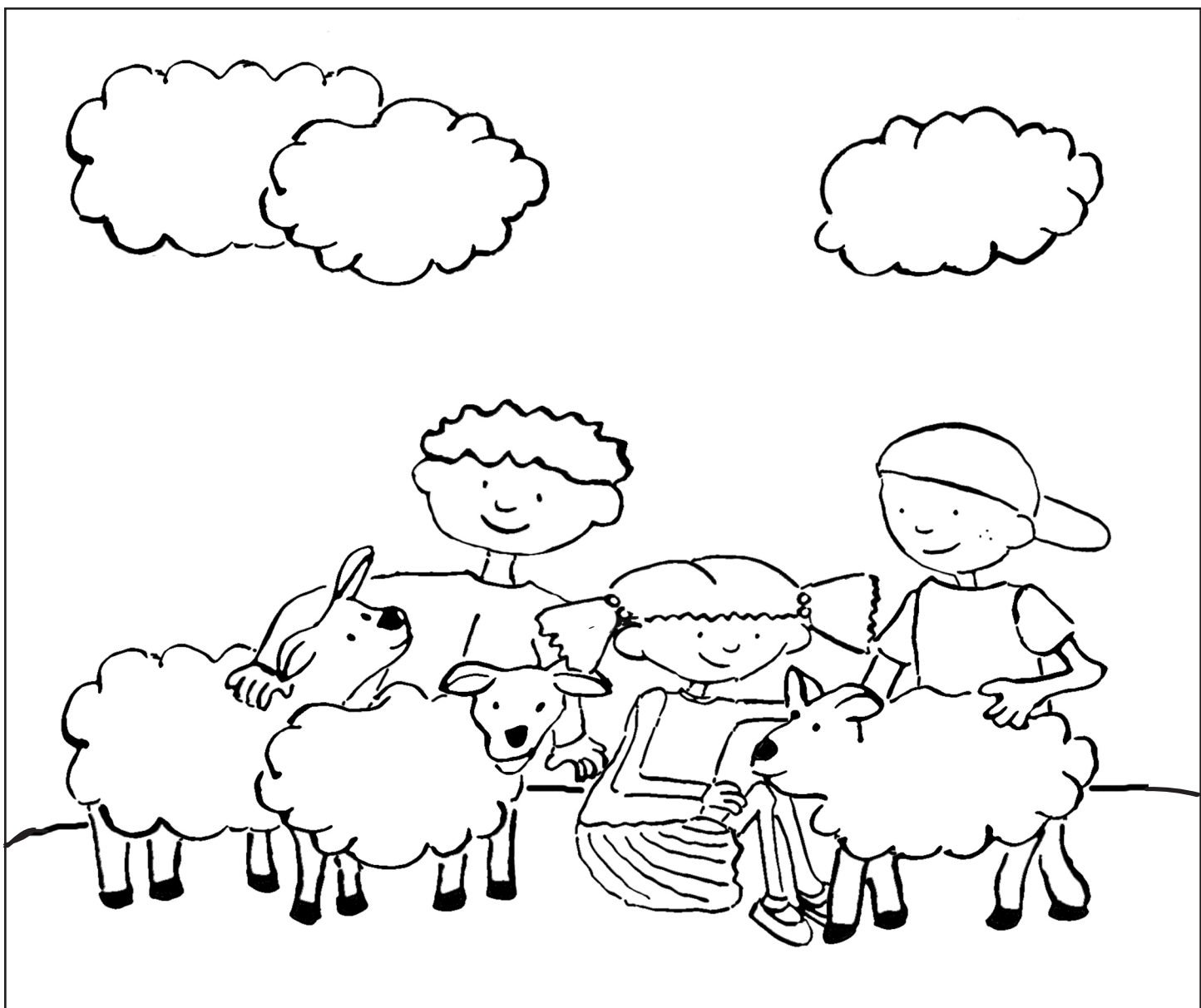
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Do you know which clouds look like a flock of sheep?

She is playing the role of all living things, which includes plants and animals.

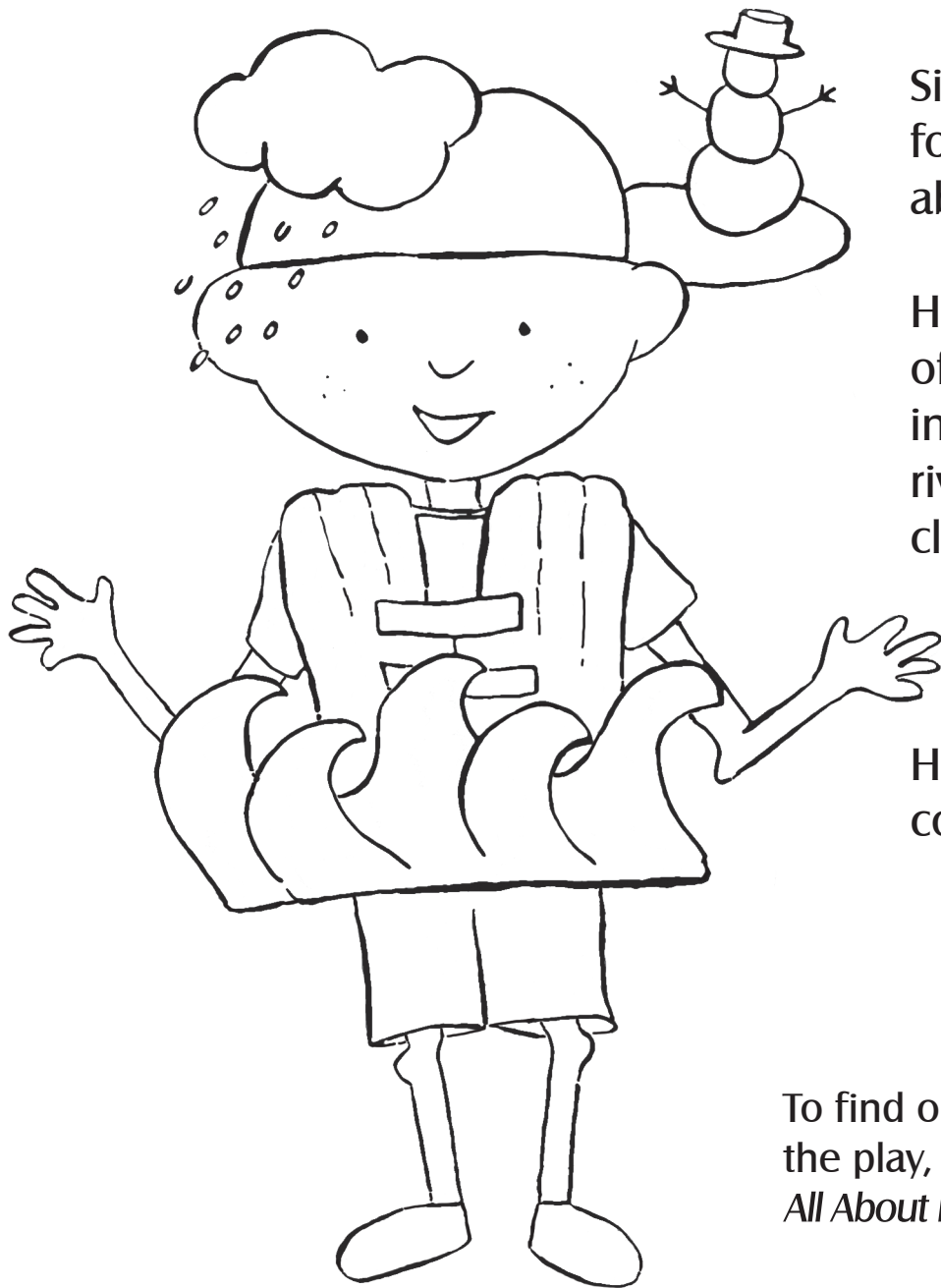

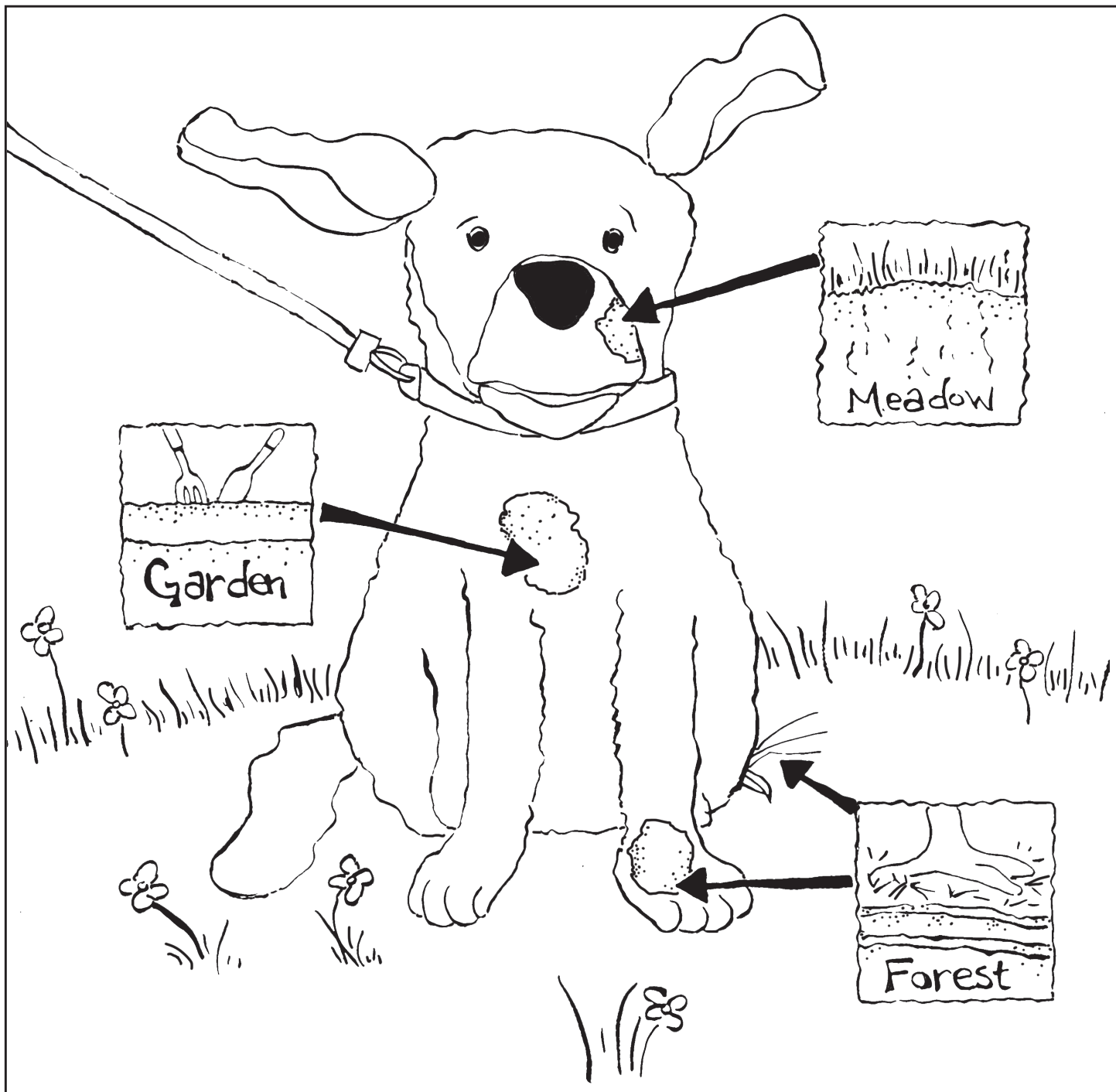
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Scoop is covered in soil! He's been digging holes in three places. Soils from different places can be different colors.

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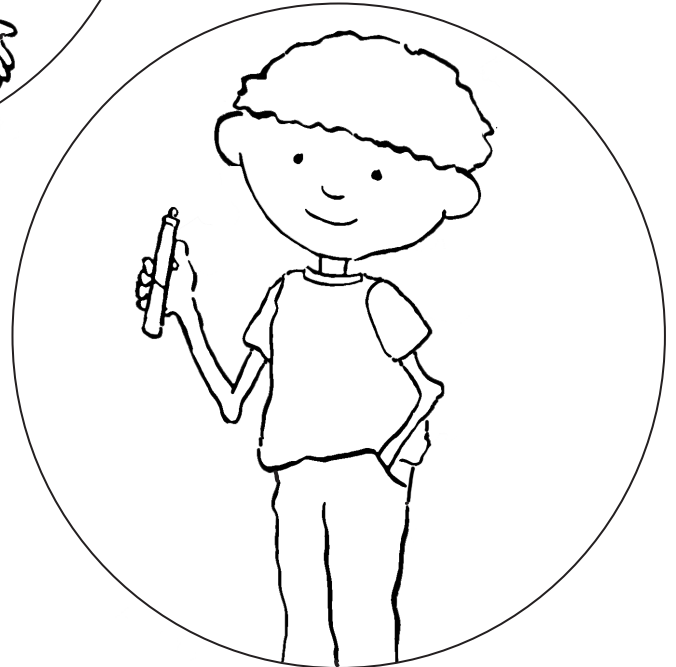
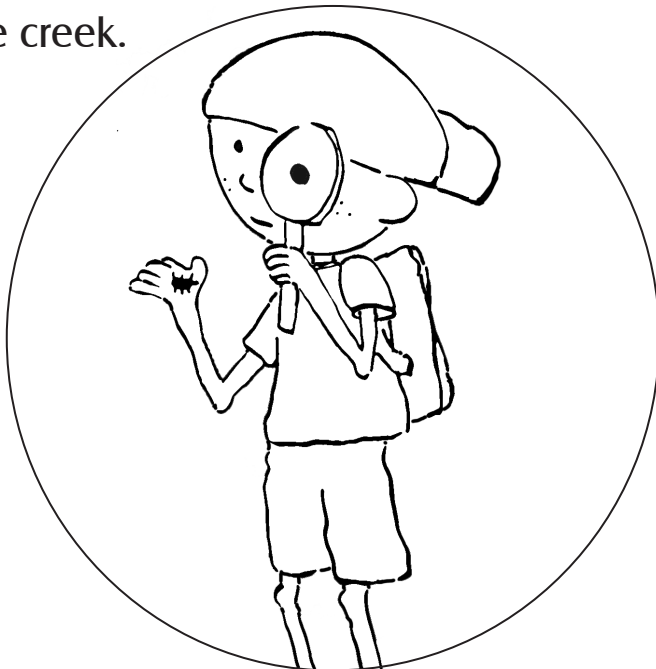
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Anita, Dennis, and Simon are bringing science instruments along on their field trip to Willow Creek.
