



# STS-130



## The Mission

Space shuttle Endeavour's STS-130 mission will deliver the last major NASA module, the Tranquility node, and cupola to the International Space Station. The six-member crew will perform three spacewalks during the 13-day mission to attach Tranquility to the Unity node on the station. The cupola's seven windows will provide an almost 360-degree view of space and will be used as a control room for robotics and living section for crew members.

This is the 130th space shuttle flight, Endeavour's 24th flight and the 32nd shuttle flight to the space station.

## The Crew

Commander George Zamka, a veteran of two previous spaceflights, will lead the six-member crew. Terry Virts will serve as pilot on his first space shuttle flight.

Mission specialists are Robert Behnken, Kathryn Hire, Nicholas Patrick and Stephen Robinson.
