WINTER BREAK ACTIVITY:

Craft Stick Aircraft

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Use the wooden clothespin as the body of the aircraft
- 2. Create wings with craft sticks-glue them to the body of the aircraft
- 3. If making a rotorcraft, create an X-shape with two sticks for the rotors
- 4. Cut smaller sections of craft sticks for the tail sections Be careful when cutting craft sticks since they can be difficult to cut. If younger children are making aircraft, have an adult help with this step.
- 5. Decorate your aircraft using markers or paint if desired
- 6. (Optional) Add thin strips of crepe paper streamers if desired



MATERIALS:

- Wooden clothespins (1 per plane)
- Wooden craft sticks
- Utility or hobby knife
- Cutting surface
- Glue
 (Hot glue is recommended but
 wood or school glue also works)
- Paint or markers
- Optional: crepe paper streamers
