

#### **NASA JOBS SUPPORTED**

There are 56 NASA federal employees and 12,246 contractors\* in the state of Kentucky.

For every NASA civil servant job located in Kentucky, an additional 10\*\* jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA civil service employees, an additional \$4.6\*\* million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.
