

#### **NASA JOBS SUPPORTED**

There are 3 NASA federal employees and 57 contractors\* in the state of Rhode Island.

For every NASA civil servant job located in Rhode Island, an additional 35\*\* jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA civil service employees, an additional \$16\*\* million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.
