

#### **NASA JOBS SUPPORTED**

There are 4 NASA federal employees and 137 contractors\* in the state of South Dakota.

For every NASA civil servant job located in South Dakota, an additional 61\*\* jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA civil service employees, an additional \$23.7\*\* million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.
